RYKNELD SWIMMING CLUB

1. This meet is only open to members of Rykneld Swimming Club. All competitors eligible for trophies, aggregate awards, medals and points must be fully paid up for annual membership and monthly fees and have been ASA registered to Rykneld Swimming Club for at least six calendar months on the first date of the competition.
2. Age is age at 31st December 2018
3. Entry fees are £3 per 25m event and £4 for all other events. This fee is to help towards the cost of medals, engraving of trophies and any additional pool hire charges.
4. Swimmers are allowed to enter events outside their own age group, on a 'time only' basis. No awards will be made for such swims, and no points allocated.
5. All entry forms must be handed in to the club payment desk. No late entries or entries without payment will be accepted. Entry fees must be paid on or before the closing date.
6. Late entrants or swimmers ASA registered with Rykneld SC for less than the required period may be permitted time trials at the session, subject to the agreement of the Promoter and the Referee provided that no administrative problems are caused.
7. This is a cardless meet. Swimmers will not need to sign in at the start of each session. We will assume you are doing all the events that you enter on your entry form. Anyone wishing to withdraw from an events should notify us as soon as possible.
8. Medals will be awarded to the first six placings in each event. Trophies will be awarded to the winners of all events. A participation medal will be awarded to all swimmers who do not receive any other award.
9. All Championship and Aggregate trophies are perpetual and cannot be won outright
10. All trophies must be returned promptly to the club when requested, and in a thoroughly cleaned condition. Any loss or damage to trophies, whatever the cause, shall be reported to the club. Rykneld Swimming Club reserve the right the claim from the holder the cost of repair or replacement should it be warranted.
11. Rykneld Swimming Club reserves the right to withhold the presentation of trophies and medals to swimmers who have left the club or are in default of any fees due, subject to the discretion of the club committee.
12. Rykneld Swimming Club reserves the right to request the return of trophies when a swimmer leaves the club, subject to the discretion of the club committee.
13. All events will be swum on a heat declared winner basis, with the exception of the Skins event (events 17 & 18).
14. In the event of a tie the trophy will be shared.
15. **Special Awards** Most points without a win, boy and girl. Most Points at DASA (Derbyshire ASA Competitions), boy and girl. Competitive Swimmer of the year, boy and girl.

16. All trophies and medals will be presented at our annual presentation evening on Saturday 20th January 2019 at Clay Cross Social Centre.
17. **SKINS Event** The top 6 swimmers in the 200 Individual Medley event will be invited to enter the cash prize Medley Skins event. Swimmers must confirm whether they will swimming in the SKINS at the end of the first session. Should a swimmer choose not to enter, or fail to confirm they are swimming, then their place will be offered to the next fastest.
18. Lane allocation and stroke choice for each heat will be selected by draw with the slowest swimmer in each heat being eliminated until two swimmers are left to compete the final heat.
19. Heats for all Championship events will be swum in speed order, irrespective of age group and seeded according the entry time submitted, the slowest swimming first. Wherever possible the fastest six swimmers will constitute the final heat, and this will be spearheaded.
20. **Notes:** Heat Declared Winners (HDW) means that the final placings in the event are decided by the swimmers' heat times. It should therefore be noted that although a swimmer may win their particular heat, his/her time could be slower than those of swimmers in earlier or later heats.
21. The date and time of all Championship sessions could be subject to change due to unforeseen circumstances. Please check the club noticeboard or our website regularly for details of any alterations.
22. Only swimmers, officials and helpers will be allowed on poolside.
23. No glass or disposable drinks bottles on poolside. Refillable drinks bottles must be used.
24. The small pool will be out of bounds throughout the event.
25. Swimmer access to poolside is through the changing rooms only. Footwear must be worn in all other areas of the leisure centre.
26. We will be unable to run this meet without the required number of officials/timekeepers and helpers. If your child is swimming please ask how you can help, even if it is only for one session. Helpers will not be charged a spectator fee for the session(s) they volunteer for.
27. Photography and videoing is NOT permitted. This applies to all types of cameras including those built into mobile phones, iPads and similar devices. We reserve the right to ask anyone contravening this policy to leave the gala, without refund.
28. Any conditions not covered by this information will be at the discretion of the promoters, Rykneld Swimming Club
